## **BCEA Clinic Code of Conduct**

I will act in accordance with my provincial sport organization's Code of Conduct as well as the BCEA Clinic Code of Conduct.

## Respect for others

- I agree to act with respect toward all those I come into contact with through sport. This means I refrain from comments or behaviours which are abusive, offensive, racist, sexist or otherwise belittling or demeaning to others.
- I do not harass or tolerate harassment by others.
- I respect others as persons and treat them with dignity.
- I respect the privacy of others.
- I do not endanger the safety of others through my actions.

# Respect for self

- I act with fairness and integrity in the pursuit of excellent sport.
- I practice drug-free sport and accept doping control.
- I avoid the abuse of alcohol and illegal drugs.

# Respect for the horse

- If there is a need to use medications to calm, tranquilize, or mask lameness on any horse in my care, during the clinic, I will bring it to the attention of the BCEA representative prior to administering the medication.
- I do not use excessive disciplinary action when dealing with any horse in my care.
- I always keep the comfort and safety of any horse in my care paramount at all times.

#### Respect for property

• I respect the property and livelihood of others, which includes refraining from vandalism, theft, and other forms of mischief.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action in accordance with the Discipline Policy of BCEA. Such action may result in losing the privileges of participation in this BCEA clinic, from membership in BCEA, and other privileges, including the opportunity to participate in BCEA activities.
