MEMBERSHIPS:

To participate in this clinic, all riders must obtain:

- Either a Full or Non-Competitive BCEA Membership
- Horse Council Membership (or out of province/country equivalent)
- Either Full or Supporting CVES Membership (For insurance purposes)

INTRO TO EVENTING:

If you are a rider from any discipline and have not competed in more than 2 Starter divisions at a Horse Trials, or if you haven't ridden for years and need a total refresher, you are invited to participate in the Introduction to Eventing Clinic.

There will be a lecture, parents and coaches are strongly encouraged to attend. Time of lecture to be determined.

PACE:

If entries warrant, pace will be available Friday 3:00 - 6:00, Saturday and Sunday. No Pace on Monday. Sign up times for the pace clinic will be posted at CVES. Please let us know if you want a Friday time.

DRESSAGE:

Sandra Verda-Zanatta will be available for Private Dressage lessons on Saturday (28th) and Sunday (29th).

Lessons will be private and are a cost of \$105. These lessons must be pre-booked on the entry form. Lessons will be in the sand arena.

STABLING:

Stabling will be outdoor paddocks. You must bring a stall guard. Shavings are \$15/bale. Must be pre-purchased. Bedding will **not** be available for purchase on site.

WAIVERS:

The waiver has been combined and will be for both BCEA and CVES. There is an over the age of majority waiver (19 and older) and under age of majority which must be signed by a parent/guardian.

YOUNG RIDERS:

Young Rider subsidies are available as a \$50 reimbursement to those who sign up and participate in BCEA volunteer opportunities throughout the season. For complete information, sign up sheets and YR membership forms please visit the YR page on the BCEA website.

ACTIVITIES:

The committee is still working out the details for all the activities at camp. There will be educational talks, trivia/jeopardy night, mocktail demonstrations, a potluck and more! Stay tuned for more details.

CAMPBELL VALLEY GROUNDS:

Campbell Valley is part of Metro Vancouver Parks and camp fires are not allowed. Based on the fire rating at the time of camp, propane fires/barbeques may be allowed.

Bikes are prohibited on the Shaggy Mane Trail which leads from stabling to the Equestrian Center. Please ensure you ride your bikes up the road.

Dogs are welcome but must be on a leash at all times. Metro Vancouver does have people patrolling and enforcing this rule.

OF NOTE:

To enjoy and get the full benefit of this clinic, it is important that you are prepared to ride out of an arena, in a group, over uneven terrain.

Every effort will be made to limit groups to 4 (maximum of 5) riders. Groups can expect to have 1 1/2 hour lessons.

Requests will be met to the best of the organizing committee's ability, beginning with the highest level riders. However, please note that YOU MAY NOTE GET YOUR REQUESTED CLINICIAN.

Hard vests are mandatory!
